## SAT Scholarship Guidelines

Prospective and new students must be fully admitted to the Salt Lake Community College with the intention to enroll in a School of Applied Technology (SAT) program. If planning on relying on the scholarship for tuition and fees, students should not register for courses until they have met with their advisors and have received confirmation regarding their eligibility for the scholarship.

Requests must be made from the student's "BruinMail" email address.

Only one program of study per year will be considered, as indicated in the Student's admission application or current active record.

Current students may apply for the scholarship but would only qualify for the remainder of their program courses or payment blocks, provided the student meets acceptable academic progress.

Awards will be made only for courses/blocks that have not yet been paid for. No retroactive payments will be made for past courses, nor those for which payment has already been transacted.

If an award is made, the scholarship will pay for the tuition and fees assessed by the program courses on a block per block basis. No cash refunds will be made to students who drop their courses, or if their tuition and fees have already been paid from another source such as Pell grants, sponsorship, etc.

Further distributions will be made for outstanding tuition and fees as long as students continue to meet acceptable academic progress.

Applicants will receive an award letter provided eligibility criteria has been fully met.
