Information

- Program has become an Early Enrollment program with Salt Lake Community College.
- Program is open to ALL students from ALL school districts.
- Program is open to ALL students who have completed their junior year of high school.

Steps to participation in the Surgical Technology program

1. Apply to Salt Lake Community College, Early Enrollment:

2. Submit applications by the end of January of high school junior year: <http://www.slcc.edu/surgicaltech>
**Must be 18 by mid August the summer after High School graduation

Preliminary Coursework

- ♦ MA 1100 Medical Terminology—Must be taken before Senior year.
- ♦ COMM 1010 Elements of Effective Communication and ENGL 1010 Intro to Writing—May be taken Junior year, the summer between Junior year and Senior year, or Senior year.
- ♦ BIOL 1610/1615 College Biology—Must be taken no later than the summer between Junior and Senior year.*

*To enroll in BIOL 1610/1615 College Biology requires:
1) Math ACT Score of 20 or SLCC College Placement Test score for 5-9.9) Reading ACT Score of 18 or SLCC College Placement Test score for Reading placement into English 1010
Note: A C grade or better must be earned in BIOL 1610/1615 College Biology to enroll in BIOL 2320/2325 Anatomy.
